The Richardson Police Department offers non-paying internships during Fall and Spring semesters to provide a basic understanding of the operations of a law enforcement agency and offer personal insight into students' long-term career and learning goals.



Interns work 6 hours per week along with 2 hours of optional assignments, such as Patrol ride-alongs, 9-1-1 call observations, training exercises, or community events — totaling 120 hours per semester. Learn from staff in Investigations, Patrol, Detention, Communications, Crime Prevention, Records, Property, Crime Scene, Media Relations, Training & more!

Requirements:

- Junior or Senior studying a field related to law enforcement
- Acceptable criminal background and driving history
- Passed polygraph test and drug screen
- 2.75 minimum GPA
- 18+ years of age
- U.S. citizen
- Enrollment for class credit from a university
- Signed confidentiality agreement
